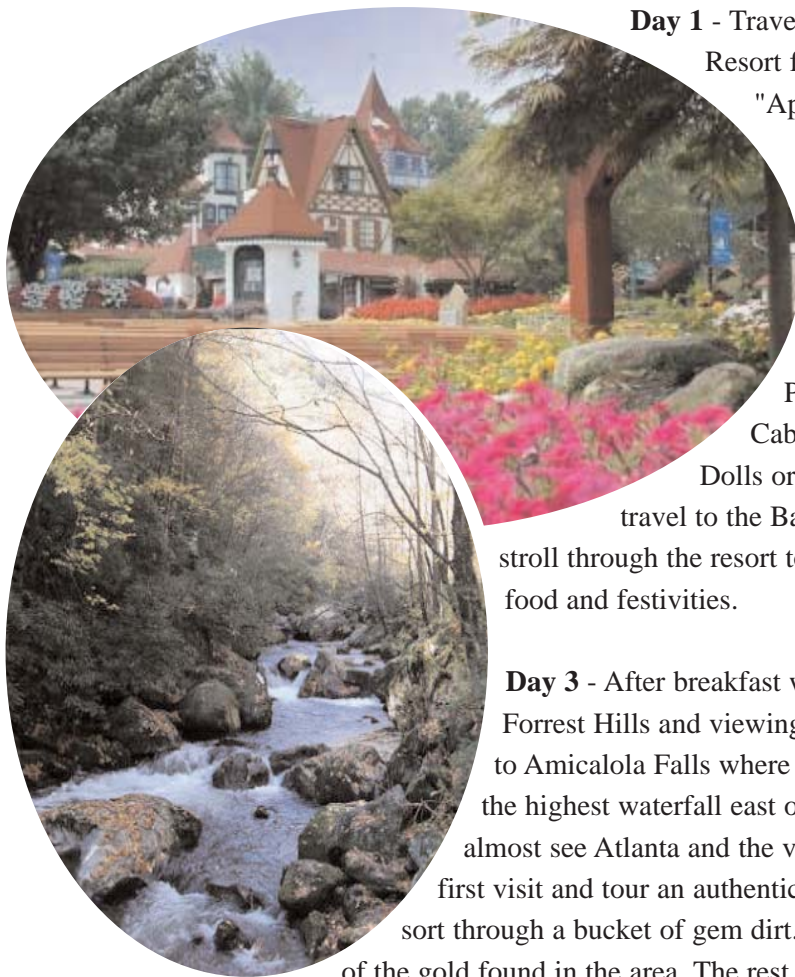

# Fall Foliage Retreat

4 Days October 25-28, 2009



**Day 1** - Travel to Dahlonega, GA. Check into the The Forrest Hills Resort for a three night stay. Dinner is included in the Resorts "Appalachian Cuisine" restaurant.

**Day 2** - Begin the day with a hayride at Burt's farm through the popcorn and pumpkin fields, across a mountain stream, up a winding mountain to a panoramic hilltop view of Burt's farm and nearby Amicalola Falls. On the way to Helen we stop and tour The Chestattee Wildlife Preserve and stop in Cleveland, Ga. with a stop at the Cabbage Patch Hospital, where the original Cabbage Patch Dolls originated and watch the birthing of a new baby. Next, we travel to the Bavarian town of Helen, Ga. where we will spend time to eat, stroll through the resort town and shop. In the evening we attend the Octoberfest for food and festivities.

**Day 3** - After breakfast we begin by strolling the mile of paved pathways of Forrest Hills and viewing the many colors of the fall leaves. We then motor to Amicalola Falls where you can walk across the bridge and be up close to the highest waterfall east of the Mississippi River. From the top of the falls you can almost see Atlanta and the view is breathtaking.. We next motor to Dahlonega where we first visit and tour an authentic underground gold mine plus a chance to pan gold ore, and sort through a bucket of gem dirt. After the tour we visit the Gold Museum and get a history of the gold found in the area. The rest of the day you are free to eat, stroll through downtown Dahlonega (all shops are on the National Historic Registry) and shop. For supper we enjoy a horse-drawn Chuckwagon ride to the River House for steak & chicken cooked on a grill with all the trimmings, plus a bonfire, live entertainment and more.

**Day 4** - Depart for home.
