

Miami -South Beach

3 Days May 4-6, 2010



Day 1 - Enroute to Miami we stop and visit Morikami Gardens, the center for Japanese arts and culture in South Florida. The Gardens are ranked in the Top 10 of all Gardens outside of Japan. Here there are six different gardens each representing a unique historical era and theme. You will also have time to view the collections of the Morikami Museum featuring fine arts and folk arts from Meiji period and earlier. Overnight lodging is at the Crowne Plaza Sawgrass Mills. It is walking distance to the Mall and many restaurants, plus they offer a free shuttle. Free Evening and dinner on own at Sawgrass Mills includes a canvas shopping bag and a coupon packet.



Day 2 - Your morning includes a visit to the Bal Harbour Shops then time for lunch at the Bayside Marketplace. Your afternoon will be spent at the world famous Fairchild Tropical Botanic Gardens a facility dedicated to exploring, explaining and conserving the world of tropical plants. A horticultural center that has the world's greatest living collection of palms and cycads. Our visit begins with a 45 minute Tram Tour that is an overview where you will discover Fairchild has carefully orchestrated art and science. Another great feature to our visit is the Japanese artist Yayoi Kusama, known for her distinctive sculptures and paintings that involve hand-worked repetition and bold patterning,, is exhibiting works from an exuberant new sculptural ensemble "Flowers that Bloom at Midnight." As the afternoon closes we return to the Crown Plaza Hotel and you enjoy another free evening.

Day 3 - This morning you tour Vizcaya. Built by agricultural industrialist James Deering in 1916, Vizcaya Museum & Gardens features a main house, ten acres of formal gardens, a hardwood hammock, and soon-to-be-restored historic village. This estate was built in a decade in which Gilded Age cultural standards were enlivened by the irreverent spirit of the dawning Jazz Age. It also introduces visitors to Miami's place in that era—a time when America's wealthiest industrialists created lavish homes inspired by the palaces of Europe. Following our morning tour of the home and gardens, you'll have a chance to buy lunch in the Vazcaya Café before we start home.
